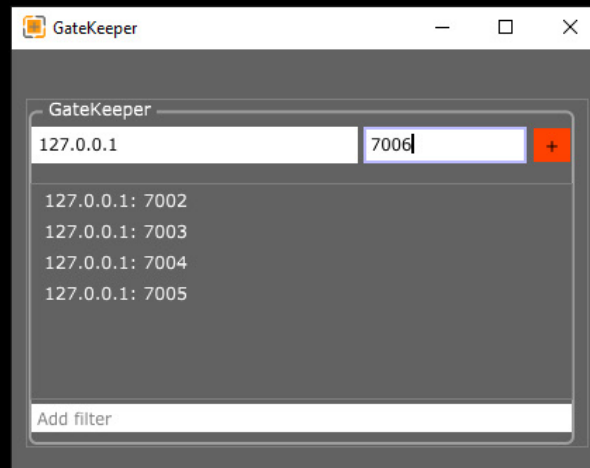

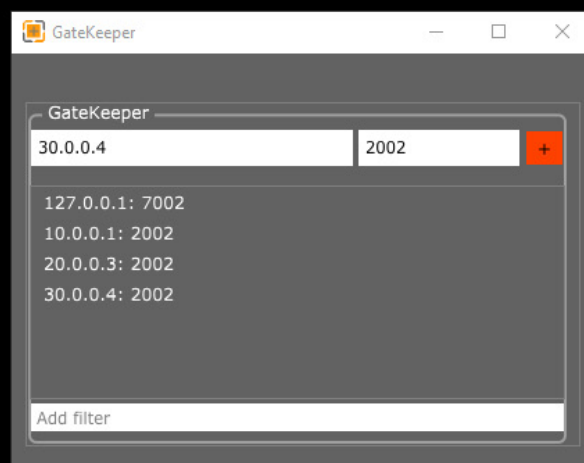

Using Gate Keeper

With Gate Keeper you can reroute your OSC messages from Resolume to multiple devices. Simply add an IP Address with a corresponding Port number and GateKeeper will reroute the OSC messages to that Address.



Gate Keeper now sends OSC from Resolume to multiple ports on to the Local Host on 127.0.0.1



Gate Keeper now sends OSC from Resolume to multiple Computers with different IP Addresses

Using Gate Keeper

For Gate Keeper to work properly you'll need to setup these OSC Settings in Resolume. In Resolume make sure to set your OSC Output to Localhost and the Outgoing Port to 7001
